

Serve like Jedi to Celebrate May the Fourth!

Lesson Plan

- 1. As students come into the class, play some Star Wars music to set the mood. I recommend Yoda's theme because of the connections to the Jedi but go with what you like.
- 2. Once class has started, begin going through the PowerPoint. As you discuss each slide, prompt your students to provide ways they can serve their community in a similar fashion. As students provide answers, write them on the board. If students are struggling, you could always have them Think-Pair-Share if you think that would help.
 - a. For example, when you discuss how the Jedi view the environment as part of the Force. Prompt them to think of ways that they can protect and preserve their environment.
- 3. Once you have gone through the PowerPoint, let students choose their "I Served Like a Jedi" sign from the ones provided at Star Wars in the Classroom.
- 4. (Optional Activity) Have a Star Wars Trivia Contest.
 - a. You can get an easy set of Star Wars Trivia Questions from the "Star Wars Reads Day" packet.
